Proposal Requirements

- Applicants must be from or affiliated with a Wisconsin 501(c)(3) Nonprofit Organization.
- Applications must be submitted by Friday, October 30, 2020.
- Submittal acts as an agreement to be featured on Roth Cheese's social accounts and homepage upon winning to promote the program and the grantee's non-profit.

Essay Requirements

In 1,500 words or less, please include the following:

- A proposal summary that includes the most general description of the use of the funds, and a sentence on how this will empower the community.
- An organization description and history on the nonprofit to be funded by the requested grant, major accomplishments of the organization and an explanation of how the description you provide makes your organization an appropriate grantee.
- A background section that provides an explanation of the problem that has created the need for the program that will be funded by the requested grant.
- A project description that should give a detailed description of the program that will be funded by the requested grant. This description should explain the goals of the project, how they will be achieved, how success or failure will be measured, what services you promise to deliver to what population and what results you expect to bring about.
